"I'll email the document to myself so I can work on it from home."

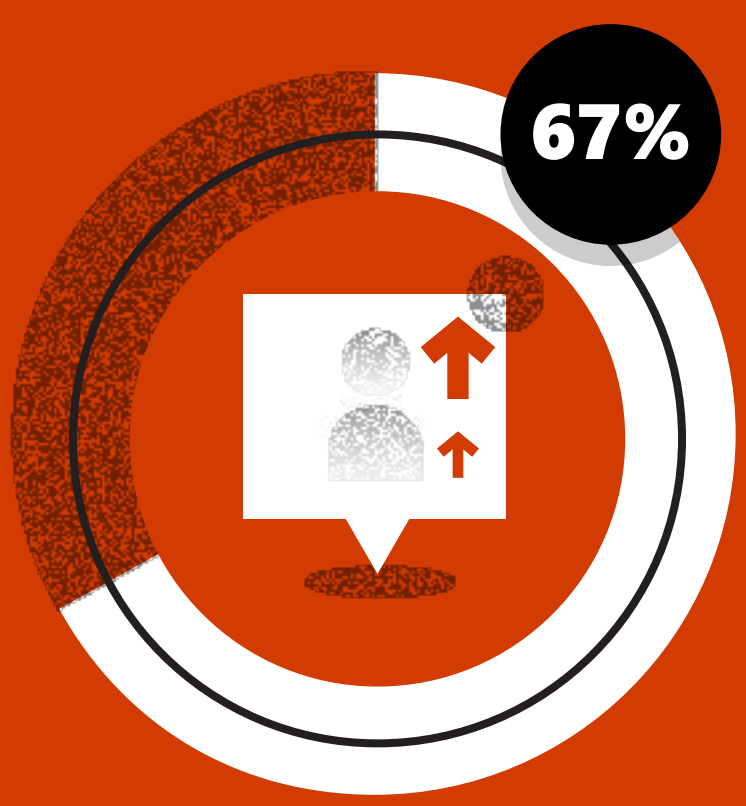
"She's not answering her work phone because she's working from home; try her cell."

"My meeting with a customer ran long, so I'll join the conference call when I get back to my desk."

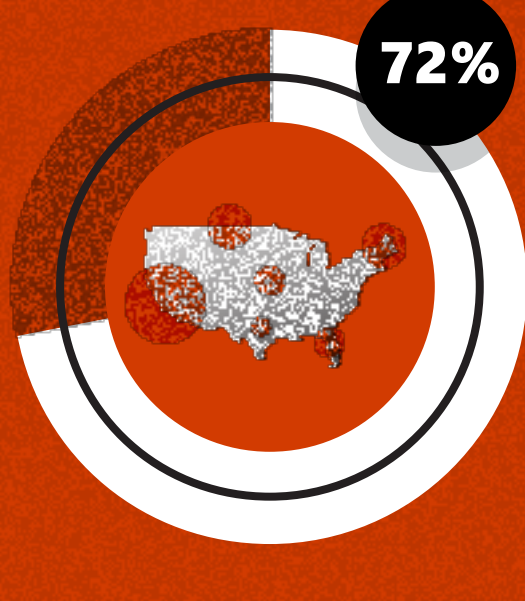

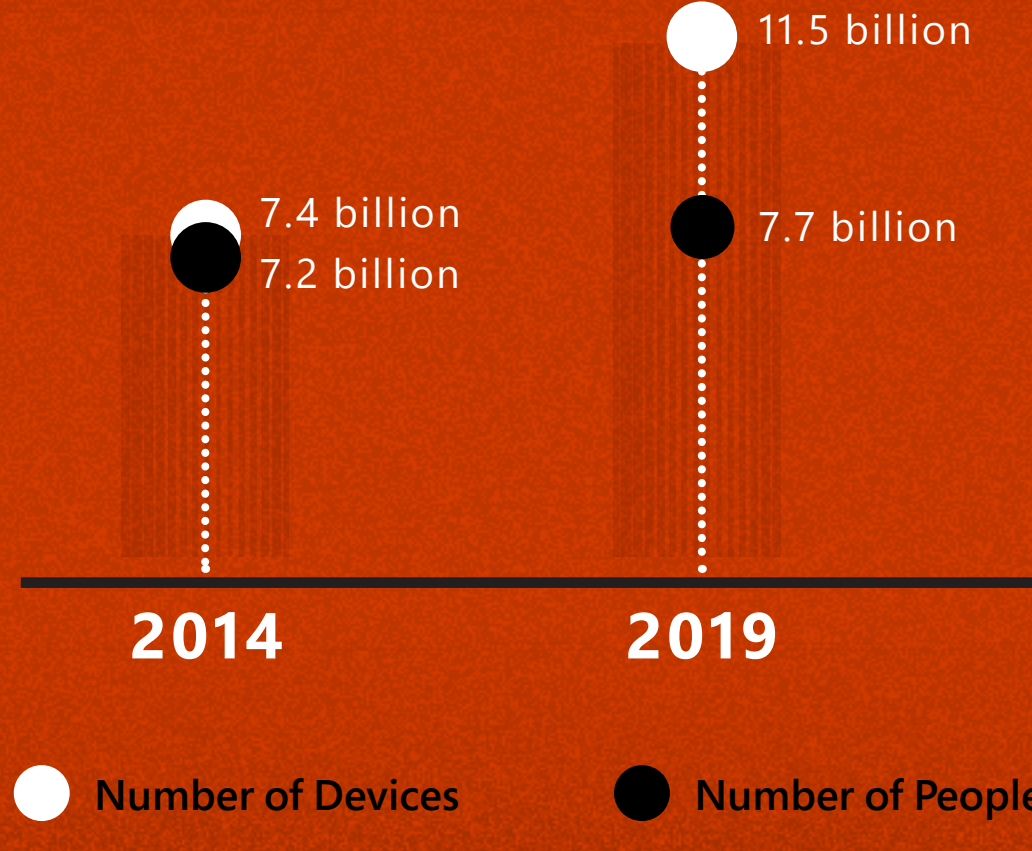

### Organizations adopting mobile workstyles cite happier, more productive employees and lower costs.

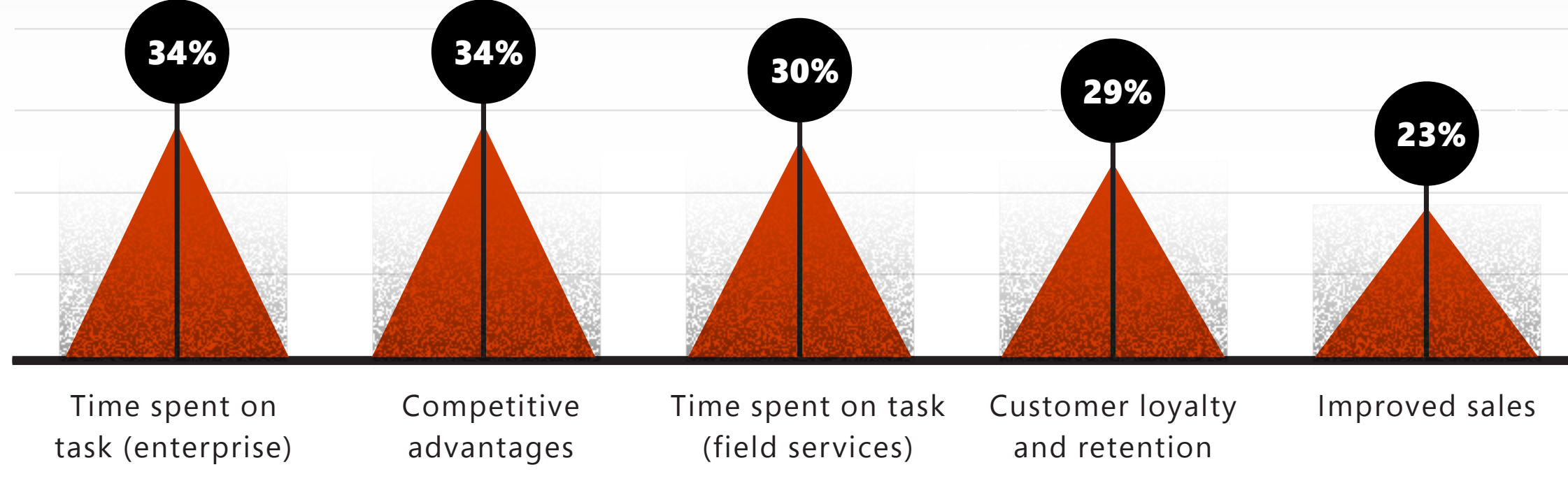


### Each remote worker has been estimated to produce 240 extra hours of work per year.

That's 6 additional weeks of work...

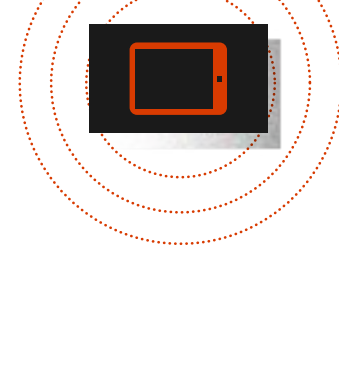

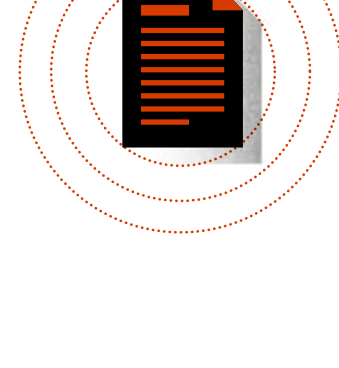
